

FireSmart Door Hanger Template

Please note: Only a qualified Local FireSmart Representative or Wildfire Mitigation Specialist should be completing the checklist on this door hanger.

Below is the template for the FireSmart Door Hangers. The size is 4.25" W x 11" H. Add FireSmart partner content into the areas outlined in red. Do not adjust or re-design this template. Once the partner logos and email addresses are added to this template, save the PDF file with a unique name. Email this completed PDF to the print vendor chosen to print the hanger.

Print Considerations

Inform your printer that the dieline (the line along which the final printed door hanger will be cut) can be accessed in Adobe Acrobat:

Click on these transparent fields to include FireSmart project partner logos. JPG or PNG files work best.
