



# FireSmart<sup>™</sup> BC Library Program

## About the Program:

The FireSmart BC Library Program is the first children's literacy program dedicated to wildfire resiliency! The Library Program was designed to help children understand what it means to live with wildfires and the role they can play in mitigating the impacts of wildfires on their home and community. Children can team up with Ember to build a FireSmart BC!

This document is for Community Resiliency Investment (CRI) applicants to provide guidance on how to acquire funding and assist with the implementation of the Library Program to their local library, First Nation, regional district, or municipality. Resources included under this program are a colouring contest, story time videos, Ember Activity Kits, and Wildfire Resiliency Literacy Kits.

### Funding:

Libraries in BC operate in different ways, some operate independently, and others operate on a regional level (with one central library and many branches that share resources). Some regional libraries follow regional district boundaries, whereas others are very large and encompass multiple regional districts.

Due to the variability in how libraries operate, CRI funding has been offered in two ways. For libraries with multiple branches that share resources, there is \$550 designated per branch. For example, a library with 10 branches could apply for \$5,500. For libraries that operate independently, \$1,800 is available.

For non-library groups such as First Nations, local government, and regional districts that would like to have this program independent of their library, \$1,800 is available.

Please see Table 1 in the Appendix to learn more about the libraries near you and how this program can best work in your community. Depending on how your local library operates, it may make sense to work with other municipalities or regional districts to pool funding, or it may work better to simply choose a branch in a high risk area and





support it independently as you would with the independent libraries or other non-library groups.

#### Working with libraries:

To implement within a library system, it is important to connect with your local library. Reach out to your local library to see if they would support this program as they are essential to the success of this program. This program was designed with the Thompson-Nicola Regional Library to be compatible with existing library programming in the effort to make integration as seamless as possible. Given the success seen with Thompson-Nicola Regional Library, we have had numerous libraries express interest in this program.

#### **Resources:**

a. Coloring Contest

Share a PDF of the <u>Colouring Page</u> with your local library to print off and purchase some <u>Ember stuffed animals</u> for the prizes.

b. Ember Activity Kits:

Purchase and assemble Ember Activity Kits to share with local families. At the library, children can take home these kits to learn more about FireSmart. Kits can be kept together in brown paper bags with a <u>label</u> stapled on the top.

#### Materials:

- Ember Colouring book
- Pencil Crayons \*optional, can be cut to meet budget
- Ember Sticker
- Ember Bookmark
- Printed Ember Word Search Game
- Printed Ember Matching Game





#### c. Storytime Videos

These videos are available online for all to view on the FireSmart BC Library Program webpage. Firefighters from each Fire Centre have read wildfire themed stories to Ember.

#### d. Wildfire Resiliency Literacy Kits

Literacy kits are a collection of books and activities used by libraries to explore different themes and topics. Check in with your local library to see how they use them. At the Thompson-Nicola Regional Library, these kits were shared amongst library branches, and were able to be loaned out to teachers, daycares, and parents. The kits from the FireSmart BC Library Program explore the topic of wildfire resilience in an approachable way for young children. Depending on the size of the program, one or two kits may be appropriate, but speak with your local library for their insight.

- Printed copies of the FireFighter Cookbook
- Books (list of approved books is in the Wildfire Resiliency Literacy Kit Booklet)

This program does not include any support for events, but should you want to engage with in person events with your local library we encourage you to do so. Speak to your local library as there may be interest in having a story time, fire truck visit, Ember visit, an information booth, or a FireSmart presentation for adults.
