- Perform mitigation work based on recommendations from a FireSmart Assessment in the Immediate, Intermediate, and Extended Zones
- Vegetation management including pruning, brushing, and chipping.
- Gear maintenance including daily inspections, cleaning, and general maintenance.
- Organize/participate in Wildfire Community Preparedness Day, emergency preparedness fairs, community meals, farmer's markets, local sporting events, school presentations, and trade shows to distribute FireSmart information.
- Able to work in all-weather types, including heat, cold, rain and snow as well as various terrain types.
- Work and travel in rural and remote areas.
- Support the FireSmart Coordinator in the implementation of 's FireSmart program.
