Summary of Position:

The Wildfire Mitigation Specialist is responsible for the facilitation of the FireSmart Home Partners Program and other related activities within the program boundaries of . The position will ensure that homeowners can access detailed home assessments to reduce their wildfire risk.

Wildfire Mitigation Specialist Responsibilities:

Duties include, but are not limited to the following:

- Work collaboratively with the Local Home Partners Program Coordinator or FireSmart Coordinator to deliver the FireSmart Home Partners Program Home Assessment.
- Schedule and deliver awareness campaigns and public education activities on the FireSmart Home Partners Program
- Schedule FireSmart Home Assessments for completion under the FireSmart Home Partners Program
- Based on hazard assessments, provide FireSmart recommendations to homeowners that reduce the wildfire hazards on their properties
- · Complete documentation, edits, and follow-up for the FireSmart Home Partners Program
- Support the implementation of a CRI FireSmart Rebate Program in your area of designation

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- · Knowledge in wildfire behavior and wildfire management principles.
- Demonstrated risk assessment and risk mitigation knowledge and ability.
- Knowledge of the FireSmart Home Partners Program.

- Ability to work with and provide education to the public in a one-on-one and group setting.
