The BC FireSmart Committee undertook a survey of 1,000 British Columbians to understand awareness levels of the wildfires and programs offered by FireSmart BC.




Over 90% of British Columbians believe the issue of wildfires is either an important issue or the most important issue facing BC.




British Columbians believe wildfires are going to get worse, climate change is primarily responsible, but if everyone works together the impact of wildfires can be reduced.




For British Columbians, climate change and the environment is considered by *most* important issue facing the province.
