EVENT

British Columbia continues to face the realities of a changing wildfire landscape. With wildfire seasons starting earlier, ending later, and affecting communities across the province, the urgency for fire resiliency has never been more pressing. Persistent high temperatures, drought conditions, and other climate change impacts mean that action in fire preparedness is a year-round priority.

In 2026, from April 8 to April 12, more than 700 firefighting professionals, FireSmart experts and Indigenous, municipal, and community leaders will gather in Victoria for the Wildfire Resiliency and Training Summit (WRTS). This annual event will highlight the evolving role of fire on our landscapes and focus on the latest research, technology, and best practices to help communities prepare for the season ahead.

The theme for the event is **Collective Action: Empowering Communities**. The five-day gathering will begin with three days of conference, which includes keynote speakers, expert panels, workshops, and networking opportunities, followed by two days of training for firefighting professionals.

We hope you can join British Columbia's firefighters and FireSmart community as they diligently work towards protecting communities, strengthening resiliency, and reducing the impact of wildfires across the province.

AUDIENCE

Participants attending the event will include key members from First Nations, local governments, fire services, as well as FireSmart representatives, wildfire mitigation specialists, first responders, researchers and wildfire scientists, emergency managers, industry partners, and provincial representatives.

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THE OPPORTUNITY

- Registration and travel subsidy for individuals who do not have access to existing financial assistance programs
 (First Nations, students, coordinators, community champions, volunteer firefighters, etc.). The WRTS Planning
 Committee will oversee the application and review process to determine successful recipients.
- BC Wildland Firefighter Awards: In recognition of the critical role that wildland firefighters play in keeping
 the province safe, FireSmart BC, the First Nations' Emergency Services Society, and BC Wildfire Service have
 partnered to create the BC Wildland Firefighter Awards, which will recognize five firefighters (Indigenous and
 non-Indigenous) at the Summit. Each recipient will receive a personalized award plus a \$1,000 grant towards
 furthering wildfire resiliency efforts.
