



Being FireSmart is a year-round job.

Spring

- Remove debris from gutters
- Store firewood, outdoor furniture, and sports equipment at least 10 m from your home
- Prune trees and plants within 2 m of the ground
- Plan your garden with the FireSmart Landscaping Guide
- Volunteer for a Local FireSmart Collective Program Community Event

Summer

- Store all combustibles at least 10 m from your home
- Regularly remove leaves and debris from your yard
- Pack a grab-and-go bag
- Maintain lawns and grass to 10 cm or less

Fall

- Remove leaves and debris from your yard
- Prune and mow all seasonal vegetation
- Check decks and staircases for damage and debris
- Remove debris from gutters
- Schedule a free, professional FireSmart Home Assessment

Winter

- Register for the free FireSmart 101 Course
- Prepare your property for winter weather
- Create a conifer pruning and maintenance plan for spring
- Make an evacuation plan in preparation for spring
